



School Uniform List

Kindergarten - Grade 2

- White shirt options: white dress shirt, white golf shirt, or rounded-collar blouse
- Navy CCCS golf shirt
- CCCS pullover or cardigan sweater with school crest
- Grey options: dress pants, rugby pants, tennis skort, tunic, or dress shorts
- Grey socks, knee socks, or tights
- Black dress shoes
- Kindergarten only: CCCS drawstring bag (mandatory)

Wednesdays (Chapel Day) Kindergarten to Grade 2 must wear a white dress shirt or blouse with the CCCS sweater. Ties are not mandatory.

*Grades 3 - 8

- White dress shirt or collared blouse
- CCCS tie (required on Wednesdays for Grades 3 to 8)
- White or navy golf shirt
- Navy pullover or cardigan sweater with school crest
- Grey dress pants, tennis skort, tunic, or dress shorts
- Grey dress socks, or navy/grey knee socks, or tights
- Black dress shoes
- Black belt (optional for Grades 2 and 3)

Wednesdays (Chapel Day) Grades 3 to 8 must wear a white dress shirt or blouse with the CCCS tie, along with the CCCS sweater.

GYM STRIP K-8

- Red CCCS gym T-shirt and black gym shorts
- White socks and athletic running shoes
- Gym bag (optional)

*Gym strips must be laundered every week.

The Cathedral School uniform is a symbol of belonging to our school and should be worn with pride. Please note the following rules regarding uniforms and general appearance:

- Students must wear the school uniform on their way to and from school and throughout the school day, including the correct P.E. strip for gym class.
- Makeup and jewelry are not permitted, except watches, medical alert bracelets and stud earrings for those with pierced ears.
- All uniforms must be complete and kept clean and repaired.
- Gym strip should be taken home once per week (minimum) to be washed.
- Shirts should be tucked in and belts worn by students in grades 3-8.

Note: If a student is not dressed in proper uniform, the student will be asked by the teacher to return to school in proper uniform the next day. If the student returns to school without the proper uniform a second time, a note will be sent home asking for parental assistance and support. If the student is still not dressed correctly, a corrective action will be taken.

Special circumstance: If an item has been lost or is on order and has not yet arrived, we will, of course, make allowances for that.

Non-Uniform DAYS

From time to time during the school year, we may have a "Non-Uniform" day when students can choose the clothes they would like to wear to school.

The guidelines for dress on those occasions are as follows:

- No muscle shirts
- No bare midriffs
- No short shorts or excessively short skirts
- No halter tops or spaghetti straps
- No underwear showing
- No offensive slogans on T-shirts
